nursery

- Crib
- Crib Mattress
- Dresser with Changing Area
- Changing Pad and Covers (2)
- Glider/Rocker
 - Optional: Ottoman for Glider Rocker or Nursing Footstool
- Portable play yard with bassinet feature

baby bedding & décor

- Fitted Sheets (3 to 5)
- Waterproof Pads/Sheet Protectors (2 to 3)
- Receiving Blankets (4)
- Wearable Blankets (see Reality Layette)

reality layette

- T-Shirts/Bodysuits (6 to 8; long and short sleeve depending on climate)
- Blanket Sleepers/Wearable Blankets (3 to 4)
- Sleepers—lighter in weight, footed (4 to 8)
- Coveralls/Rompers (2 to 4)
- Booties/Socks (3 to 4 pairs)
- Hats (2 to 3)
- Bibs (2 to 3 drool bibs, 3 to 4 large bibs when baby starts solid foods)

for mom & dad

- Diaper Bag for around town
- Baby 411 book
- Happiest Baby on the Block book

health & safety

- Baby Monitor
- Safety Gates
- Cabinet & Drawer Locks
- Toilet locks
- Outlet Covers
- Furniture & TV Straps
- Humidifier
- Thermometer

feeding baby

- Breast Pump & Accessories
- Bottles and Nipples

If you are breastfeeding, you need:

- Expressed Milk Storage Bottles or Bags, Nursing Pads

If you are bottle-feeding, you need:

- 4 or 5 oz bottles: 6 to 10
- 8, 9 or 10 oz bottles: 6 to 10
- Slow Flow Nipples: 8 to 10
- Medium Flow Nipples: 8 to 10
- Fast Flow Nipples: 8 to 10
- Bottle cleaning supplies (bottle brush, etc).
- High Chair

first aid kit

- Band-Aids (lots of them—they become badges of courage)
- sterile, non-stick dressing and tape
- “butterfly” bandages or thin adhesive strips
- Ace wrap
- a roll of gauze dressing
- rectal thermometer
- petroleum jelly
- acetaminophen (Tylenol)
- ibuprofen (Motrin, Advil)
- antibiotic ointment
- diphenhydramine liquid (Benadryl)
- saline nose drops (home made or store bought)
- decongestant nose spray (Afrin)
- 1% hydrocortisone cream
- A list of emergency phone numbers, including the National Poison Control Center (800-222-1222) or your local poison control number.
- baking soda
- tweezers
- measuring spoon, cup or dropper; you'll want one with cc/ml measurements for those tiny infant doses.
